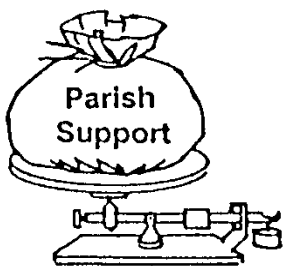

FROM THE DIOCESE OF HARRISBURG: IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED, YOU DO NOT NEED TO WEAR A MASK, UNLESS YOU WANT TOO. IF YOU ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED, PLEASE CONTINUE TO WEAR A MASK. We must continue to do our part. We are not going to “card” our parishioners as they come to Mass. **Honesty is our policy.** You must wear the mask covering the entire time you are attending Mass or any other liturgical event in our parish, including sacramental Confession. They are not permitted to be lowered at any time while in the church except to receive Holy Communion. It is not acceptable for parishioners to lower their face masks while sitting in the pew. Your mask must cover your face from your nose to your chin. (NOSES MUST BE COVERED). **Groups are not to gather in the foyer for social time.** It should be underscored that this is an act of charity, above all, not an infringement upon a personal right. Thank you to all who are following these guidelines.

Spiritual Adoption - The babies we spiritually adopted on January 29 are now 4-5 inches long and weigh 3-4 ounces. The baby's eyelashes, vocal chords and external sex organs are now present. Baby can grasp with hands and turn somersaults, and the mother may first feel baby's movements. Rapid Eye Movements (REM), indicative of dreaming, can now be recorded.
