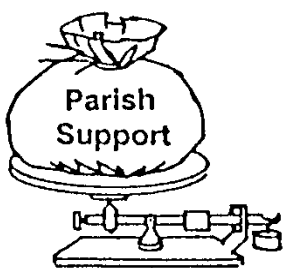

FROM THE DIOCESE OF HARRISBURG: IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED, YOU DO NOT NEED TO WEAR A MASK, UNLESS YOU WANT TOO. IF YOU ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED, PLEASE CONTINUE TO WEAR A MASK. We must continue to do our part to keep the unvaccinated as safe as we possibly can. We are not going to “card” our parishioners as they come to Mass. **Honesty is our policy.** You must wear the mask covering the entire time you are attending Mass or any other liturgical event in our parish, including sacramental Confession. They are not permitted to be lowered at any time while in the church except to receive Holy Communion. It is not acceptable for parishioners to lower their face masks while sitting in the pew. Your mask must cover your face from your nose to your chin. (NOSES MUST BE COVERED). Social distancing is to be strictly enforced. The measure of 6 feet between individuals and family groups is to be maintained while seated and moving. **Groups are not to gather in the foyer** for social time. Face masks should be worn until a person has left the church property or distanced himself or herself from the other congregants. It should be underscored that this is an act of charity, above all, not an infringement upon a personal right. Thank you to all who are following these guidelines.

Vatican International Exhibit of Eucharistic Miracles of the World St. Mary's Church will be hosting this on Saturday evening June 5th through Sunday, June 13th at noon. The times for the exhibit will be Saturday, June 5th after the 5PM Mass until 7PM, Sunday, June 6th, after Morning Masses until 3 PM. It will open Monday – Saturday after the 8 AM Mass until 2 PM and reopen from 5PM–7PM. On June 13th it will only be open until Noon. You will be able to read stories about Eucharistic events occurring across the globe, and learn about how Jesus' presence in the Eucharistic was experienced by many Saints and Mystics. Some received miraculous Communions and others were able to sustain life for years on the Eucharist alone.
