

Barn

1. Volunteer -Cleansed out
2. Materials- Heavy duty extension cords, shop lights,

Farmhouse (Sandy's House)

1. Volunteer- cleaned out,
2. Materials- beds, bathroom supplies, cots, sleeping bags, bathroom supplies, First Aid kit, disposables plates, cups, and utensils,

Temporary Chapel

1. Volunteer- putting up grille, divider wall, installing metal chimney, building a communion rail, installing sacristy cabinetry and shelves, altar platform,
2. Materials- garden lattice, plywood, wood glue, peg boards, chairs/benches with backs and kneelers, statue stands, material for large black curtain, fans,

Carpentry

1. Volunteer- putting up fence, building moveable partitions and benches w/o backs, refectory tables (5 ft long, 2.5 ft high, 2 ft. wide), wooden shelves, wooden cabinets, wooden bookshelves, simple wooden holy water founts
2. Materials- wood, fencing, saw, wood pegs and hooks, insulation

Facilitation of Workshops

1. Volunteer- one prepared meal in the evening (May 16-Sept. 8, 1-4 men) for incoming leaders of workshops, occasional cleaning of farmhouse,
2. Materials- bottled water, Styrofoam coolers, grocery cards(May 16-Sept)

Participation in Workshops/Monastery Construction

1. 2018 Masonry workshops
2. 2018 Timber-framing workshops
3. Sustainable farming/gardening/animal husbandry workshops
4. Individual workmen(farmers, carpenters, masons, etc.) who can offer their work free or discounted

Preparation for July 25

1. Volunteer- yard clean-up, preparing luncheon, putting up tent and chairs,
2. Materials- flower arrangements for altar, tent, lunch for bishop and attendants, folding tables and chairs,

Preparation for July 20

1. Volunteer- transporting nuns' boxes, unpacking and setting up of mobile home and barn
2. Materials- gas cards, supplies (see below), fresh food,
